PITTSFIELD -- Charles Walter Bonin, 78, of 12 Egremont Ave. died Friday at his winter home in Arroyo Grande, Calif. Born in Pittsfield on Feb. 10, 1927, son of J. Leon and Yvonne Dube Bonin, he was a 1945 graduate of St. Joseph's Central High School. He also graduated from the University of Massachusetts in Amherst. He was an Army veteran who served in World War II. Mr. Boning was employed by GE for 40 years, retiring in 1987 as Manager of Programmers, Information Systems. He was a communicant of Sacred Heart Church and served as a Eucharistic Minister. He was a member of GE's Quarter Century and Pensioners clubs, Wahconah Country Club in Dalton and the Berkshire Senior Golf Association. He was also a volunteer for Habitat for Humanity. He and his first wife, the former Mary Dolorita Donovan, were married April 3, 1948. She died Dec. 20, 1974. He and his second wife, the former Josephine Tiller Ramsay, were married June 19, 1976. She died May 13, 2003. He leaves a daughter, Rosemary Bonin Denton of Sheridan, Wyo.; a stepdaughter, Ellen Ramsay Berends of Oak Hills, Calif.; two stepsons, Paul Ramsay of Templeton, Calif., and Carl Ramsay of New York City, 12 grandchildren and 17 great-grandchildren.
