PETERSHAM— Sr. Simonne Bonin, 95, of the Sisters of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin, of North Main Street, Petersham, died September 2 at Assumption Residence after a long illness. Formerly known as Sister Elzéar-de-Marie, she professed 72 years of religious vows. Born in Woonsocket, R.I., Sr. Simonne was the daughter of the late Jean-Baptiste and Anastasie (Fafard) Bonin. She attended Assumption Academy in Nicolet, P.Q. Canada and pursued studies at Rivier College. After completing her religious training, Sister Simonne was sent to the United States to teach French. She excelled in imparting a great liking for the language to her primary grade students. Sister Simonne taught at various parish schools in Massachusetts, especially in Spencer, Brockton, Salem, Southbridge and Millbury. Her last assignment was at Assumption Montessori School in Petersham for some twelve years. She leaves three brothers, Herman, Robert, André Bonin, and one sister. Mrs. Cécile LaCharité from Canada, as well as nieces and nephews. A funeral Mass will be celebrated Tuesday, September 6, at 10:00 a.m. in the Assumption Residence Chapel. Burial will be in the East Street Cemetery, Petersham.
