LEOMINSTER -- David M. Bonin, 65, formerly of 100 Main St. (Sunset Towers), died early Monday morning, July 25, at the Lifecare Center of Leominster, after a long illness. He was born on March 12, 1940, in Fitchburg, and had lived most of his life in this area including 14 years as a resident of Lunenburg. Mr. Bonin was a 1957 graduate of St. Bernard's Catholic High School and served eight years in the U.S. Navy. He worked as a cook for many years at the Marconi Club in Fitchburg. He was a longtime member of the Lunenburg Rotary Club where he received the "Paul Harris Fellow" award in 1990. He was a volunteer for the Special Olympics from 1983 to 1986 and participated in the St. Joseph's School adopt-a-student program. Mr. Bonin is survived by two sisters, Donna Richard and her husband, John P., and Luann Burke and her husband, Jay; one brother, Jay Dondero, all of Leominster; five nieces and two nephews.
