

Daniel, 83, entered into eternal rest on Monday, June 24, 2002 in the Everett General Hospital (Colby campus).

He was born on November 27, 1918 to his parents Lawrence P. and Myrtle M. (Goodwater) Bunney in Minot, North Dakota. Daniel attended the Minot public schools. As he grew into young adulthood, he worked for Western Union; the CCC's and the WPA while living in Minot.

In December of 1938, he moved with his parents first to Everett and then to Skagit Co., Washington. There he helped run a family-dairy bussiness near Lyman for a number of years up until 1946. After the death of his father, Lawrence, he would relocated yet again back to Everett, Washington and he would make Snohomish Co. his home for the remainder of his life.
