

Philip John (Bonin Buney) Bunney 1847 – 1933

Philip, fifth child of Jean (John) and Rosalie (Lescault) Bonin, was born in 1847 in Contrecour, Quebec, Canada. He married Genevieve (Jenny) Guillet in 1871. She was born on January 16, 1847 in Ontario, Canada. They left Quebec around 1879 and moved... after their first two children were born... to Glen Falls, New York. Later Philip and his family moved to East Grand Forks, Minnesota until around 1900. Then the family relocated to Petersburg, ND.

Philipp worked as a carpenter; a farmer and as I recall my father said that he worked for.. a time... the Great Northern Railroad. He was able to drive a truck, too.

Jenny passed away in Oct 13, 1924, I believe, from diabetes complications. Philipp passed away on September 22, 1933 when he was eighty-six years old. Both Philipp and Jenny are buried in the Michigan Cemetery near Petersburg, North Dakota.
