

Haverhill - Walter D. Bonin, 88, a native and lifelong resident of Haverhill, died peacefully on Monday, September 10, 2018, at his home. The son of the late Octave and Clara (Lagasse) Bonin, he attended Saint James Grammar School and was a member of the Haverhill Trade School, class of 1948.
